



WILD WORDS: Submission Advice

Thinking about submitting your writing to Wild Words Adirondack Teen Writing Anthology? The deadline is March 10, 2023. Here's some insider advice:

- * Have someone else look at your writing before you send it in. This is something that all writers do! The person you share it with can give you feedback on any parts of the poem or story that aren't clear & a second pair of eyes can catch any typos.
- * Submit something that you're excited about and ready to share with the world. If your story or poem isn't something you feel comfortable with other people reading, it might not be ready for publication just yet.
- * We are unable to print photos or graphics in this anthology, so keep your submissions words-only. Still want to publish visual work? That would be perfect for a zine!
- * You must live in the North Country/Adirondack region to be published in the anthology. If that's not you, we have other resources for teen writers on the Wild Words webpage.
- * Submit a variety of different writing, while staying within the 10-page max. Why not send us a mix of essays, poems & short stories? We'll email you about which one we pick.

Wild Words: Adirondack Teen Writing Anthology is a new publication of the Adirondack Center for Writing, created to give teens a place to publish their original creative writing.
